

## Accessing Assigned Curriculum and Courses

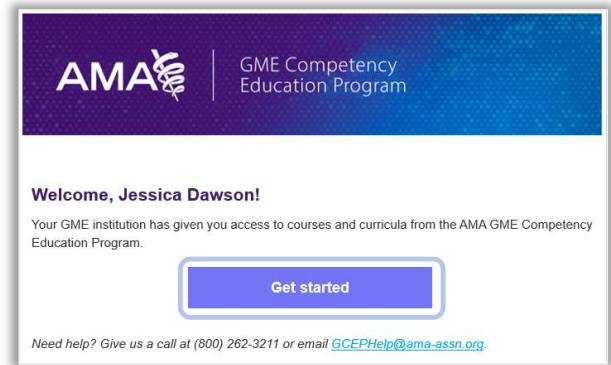
Learners are granted access to the AMA GME Competency Education Program through their GME institution and can easily access courses and assigned curriculum.

Residents and fellows also receive a sponsored AMA membership as learners on the AMA GME Competency Education Program.

Learners can access the platform directly through [www.AMAGMEOnline.org](http://www.AMAGMEOnline.org) or via their welcome email (subject line: *Welcome! Access your GME courses and curricula*).

### Step 1:

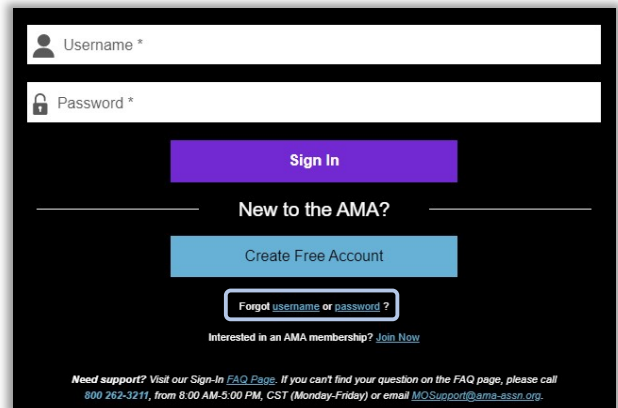
- If accessing from your welcome email, click “Get started,” then “Sign In”
- If accessing via [www.AMAGMEOnline.org](http://www.AMAGMEOnline.org), click “Sign In”



### Step 2:

From the AMA Sign In screen, login with an existing username, or click “Create Free Account” to create a username and password.

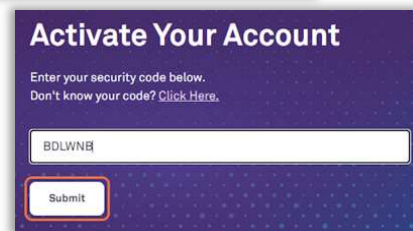
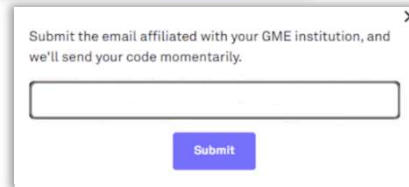
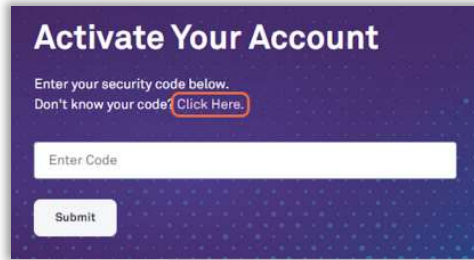
- If you are unsure of your username or password, click “Forgot username or password” to reset it.



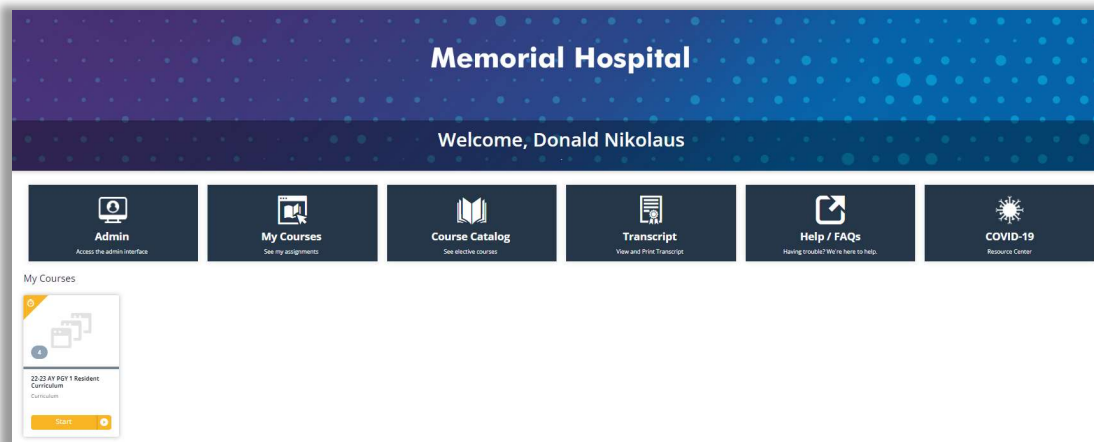
### Step 3:

When logging in, you may be prompted to request and enter a secure code.

- Request the access code by entering the email address affiliated with your GME institution.
  - This is the email address submitted to the AMA by your institution.
- Return to the page to enter the code and click Submit to access your learner dashboard, shown below.



**Step 4:** You will be taken to your learner dashboard.
